

District 19 Bookstore Bucks Q & A

What are District 19 Bookstore Bucks?

District 19 Bookstore Bucks are an incentive or reward certificate that can be redeemed in the District 19 Bookstore toward the purchase of educational or promotional materials. Each Bookstore Buck is the equivalent of \$1.00. No certificates will be hard copy and must be redeemed by May 30, 2019. Bookstore Bucks may be redeemed via the Incentives Form found on the <u>www.district19.me</u> website under the dropdown "Other".

How do I earn Bookstore Bucks?

Bookstore Bucks can be earned by clubs and members, in a variety of ways this year. Check out the District 19 website <u>http://district19.me/incentives/</u> for a complete list of incentives and rewards.

What can I buy with my Bookstore Bucks in the bookstore?

Any Toastmasters materials and merchandise that is for sale on the Toastmasters International website.

How do I know what items are in the bookstore?

You must reach out to the Program Quality Director, Theresa Mickelson, or the Club Growth Director, Jennifer Snook, to spend your Bookstore Bucks.

Can I use my Bookstore Bucks for raffle tickets at the conference?

No. Bookstore Bucks can only be used to purchase Toastmasters merchandise and materials.

Can I use my Bookstore Bucks toward the cost of my conference registration?

No. Bookstore Bucks can only be used to purchase Toastmasters merchandise and materials.

What happens if I do not use the full value of my Bookstore Bucks certificates?

Bookstore Bucks have no cash value. If you do not spend the entire value of the certificate, the balance is forfeited at the time of expiration. May 30, 2019.

Do my Bookstore Bucks expire?

Yes, your Bookstore Bucks / Incentives have an expiration date, May 30, 2019.
