Toastmasters is built on growth and all Toastmasters grow from feedback given in an effective manner. This session will explain the fine points of constructive evaluations and the Toastmasters way of strong feedback!

Team Building Workshop:

Working together allows your team to achieve success. But how do you build a strong team? The Helium Stick workshop involves participants working together in teams to communicate and to accomplish the task. This session will teach you the importance of a well-functioning team and how to apply the lessons learned during the workshop to build a strong team.

From Speaker to Trainer (Train the Trainer):

Remember, we retain 20% of what we hear; 50% of what we hear and see and 70% of what we hear, see and do! Want to learn how to train adults and become certified? Then this is the program for you!
