WHAT IS A **DISTRICT DIRECTOR CHALLENGE?** THERE ARE **ONLY 3 STEPS**, SEE BELOW!

#1. Visit a Club Program other than the one(s) you belong. Before showing up, please contact the club and let them know you are coming for a visit.

To find another club:

- Use the Find A Club link found on the Toastmasters International website
- On the District19 website click on Incentives. You'll find a list of clubs in the state.

By reaching out to the club, the members can be prepared and provide helpful information needed to locate their meeting. Take a picture to use for your 3rd step in front of the club's banner or lectern. To have even more fun with your experience, include your *Toastmaster Magazine*.

#2. Stretch yourself, **Give a Module Speech** in a club where you are a member (Better Speaker Series, Successful Club Series, or Leadership in Excellence Series) **OR Give Any Speech where you receive an Evaluation** in any club program other than one(s) where you are a member. Remember to take a picture for your 3rd step.
