Achievements must have occurred on July 1, 2025, or later. All submission forms must be submitted by May 15, 2026. All points must be spent no later than May 31, 2026. Each point translates to \$1.00 that can be redeemed for Merchandise in the TI Shop.

5-for-5 Evaluation Challenge

The 5-For-5 Evaluation Challenge is an opportunity to enhance your critical thinking and constructive feedback skills through evaluating five speeches across five distinct clubs. By actively participating in this challenge, you'll provide valuable evaluations that contribute to the growth and development of the speakers.

Note: An Outstanding Member Pin (Item #1115C) and Participation Recognition will be awarded at the D19 Spring Conference. Proof that the written evaluation was shared with the speaker is required. Submissions must be made by April 24, 2026 in order to be recognized at the D19 Spring Conference.

“New Kid on the Block” 7/1/2025 – 5/1/2026

Charter at least one new club.

Note: The club sponsor will receive District recognition, completing a requirement for the Distinguished Toastmaster award, and a laptop backpack – Item #6930.

“I Know a Guy” – 7/1/2025 – 5/1/2026

A member who provides a corporate or community club lead where we can present a Public Speaking workshop to at least 10 prospective individuals for a total of at least 4 hours.

- If the lead generates a Demonstration Meeting - 20 points.
- If that idea turns into a club being chartered, the member gets an additional 25 points. *Note: This will automatically earn the New Kid on the Block incentive as well for 75 points.*

“Why I Renewed” Fall – 8/18/2025 – 9/19/2025

Members create a 30 to 60 seconds “Why I Renewed” video, post the video on your Social Media page with the hashtag **#d19whyirenewed**, and tag the District. The member must also follow at least one of the district's social media platforms (verified by social media handle).

NOTE: The top 10 members with the most likes and shares will receive a Core Values Medallion – Item #6948.

“Why I Renewed #2” Spring – 2/16/2026 – 3/20/2026

Members create a 30 to 60 seconds “Why I Renewed” video, post the video on your Social Media page with the hashtag **#d19whyirenewed**, and tag the District. The member must also follow at least one of the district's social media platforms (verified by social media handle).
